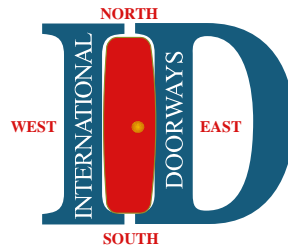

The Process:

- Contact us via email @ info@internationaldoorways.com or via telephone @ (919) 832-3706 to let us know your are interested in becoming an ID Educator Ambassador.
- We will send you a detailed information packet to share with other educators, interested participants & families.
- **Build your group! Generate excitement by getting the word out!**
- **Submit participant applications:** Have students submit applications directly to us. Reservations are on a first-come, first-served basis. Along with Application please ensure the participants include a *non-refundable deposit of \$500.00. Once the participants application is received we will contact each individual family to answer any remaining questions or concerns they may have.

Note: Once you start the process, please provide us an estimate of how many participants you think you'll be bringing. If your number of applicants differs from your initial estimate, let us know so that we can adjust our space in the program accordingly.

- **Interviews & review of applications.** It is our expectation that the participants you select will be accepted to the program. However, International Doorways reserves the right to not accept all participants referred to us by educators. We will review all participants' applications and will speak with the participant directly to assess their appropriateness for the program.
- **We meet you and your group at the chosen International Doorways journey:** We will work hand in hand with the family or you to organize all the logistics of the individual participants journey or of your group's journey!

AMBASSADOR RESPONSIBILITIES:

Note: While In-country educators will be working hand in hand @ all times with an assigned International Doorways Group Leader as well as our In-Country Support.

The responsibilities of the educator begins at the time of enrollment into the ID Educator Ambassador program to the assignment of host country and extend through the completion of the educator's report. While In-country, educators are on duty and responsible for participants twenty-four hours a day and seven days a week. Educators are required to be at least 21 years of age.

- To insure the participant's safety & welfare.
- To administer program logistics.
- To facilitate the learning experience & to encourage personal growth of the participants.

PRE-PROGRAM:

- Communicate & maintain communication with the ID head office, the participants & their families until the time of departure.

PROGRAM:

- Meet participants at selected gateway city.
- Be present & with the group throughout the program.
- Conduct orientation at host country.
- Meet with all participants within the first week to ensure everything is progressing smoothly and the participants are gaining the utmost from their experience.
- Create a collaborative relationship with our In-Country representatives/hosts.
- Maintain contact with & support all participants requesting assistance as needed.
- Carry out planned activities.
- Conduct a program evaluation at the end of the summer program.

- Submit educator's report & evaluations to the International Doorways Inc. office.
